This year in 2017 the Werribee Hockey Club will be in its 43rd season. Our humble beginnings from 1975 include playing home games at Werribee High School, Laverton RAAF Base, Price Reserve in Werribee South, and beside the Werribee Racecourse where our first clubrooms were underneath the grandstand.

A \$125,000 grant from the State Government, plus member funds enabled us to construct our \$680,000 first class synthetic ground for the start of 1999. Our new purpose clubrooms were extended in 2012.

In 2016 we had a member base of 341 members and this coming 2017 season we have 4 Senior Men's teams, 3 Senior Womens teams, 3 Masters (35+) teams, U10s up to U18s teams and like 2015 & 2016, we will have a development league of over 120 kids (5-10yo) participating in the continuing WDHL from our resource program with Hook-In-2-Hockey. In 2017, WDHL is expanding to include use of a 2nd pitch in Truganina

During our 2016 season, our club were very proud to have 6 of it's 7 Senior Teams all participate in Finals. We had 2 Representatives play for Australia in April 2016. We also had 1 junior female play in the gold medal winning state U13 side and also go on to represent us in the U13 Indoor side in January 2017 and 10 of our juniors represented the western region in the Junior State Champoinships held in July 2016. In 2017 we also have one U13 boy in the Victorian State High Performance Academy, a highly contested

much sought after position.

In 2016, our Tigers club mascot excelled in encouraging our players and entertaining the families and spectators. I have no doubt he will be on hand again in the 2017 season.

We've created the Wyndham District Hockey League. This initiative helps capture the growth area of greater Wyndham, targeting new junior players between 5-12 years old. This program develops teams from the surrounding suburbs and teaches the basics of hockey and playing modified games. The youngsters then move to represent the Werribee Hockey Club in junior interclub competitions.

Hockey is a universal sport played in over 100 countries and at both the Olympic & Commonweath games.

Hockey is a growing sport in Australia.

Hockey Victoria in 2016 had over 30,000 registered players and over 100,000 in Australia.

The Kookaburras are the number one ranked men's hockey team in the world and current holders of the World Cup. The Kookaburras are the only Australian team, male or female, to win a medal at each of the last six Olympic Games, prior to Rio 2016. Placed in the top four in every Olympic Games between 1980 and 2012, they have been Australia's most consistent performer in any Olympic team sport. The Kookaburras have an outstanding international record and for more than 30 years have been ranked in the top four nations in the world. The Kookaburras have won eight Olympic Games medals since first competing in 1956. This is in addition to its eight World Cup medals (3 gold including the below in 2014), 28 Champions Trophy medals (13 gold) and all five Commonwealth Games gold medals in 1998, 2002, 2006, 2010 and 2014.

The Hockeyroos, the Australian women's hockey team, dominated world hockey during the mid 1990s and early 2000's, with back-to-back gold medals at the 1996 and 2000 Olympic Games, the 1994 and 1998 World Cups as well as five consecutive Champions Trophy titles.

While the decade that followed did not bring as many medals, a string of excellent performances since 2012 has seen the Hockeyroos climb back up the world rankings and once again regularly challenge for the podium at major events, winning World Cup and World League silver medals and Commonwealth Games gold in that time.
